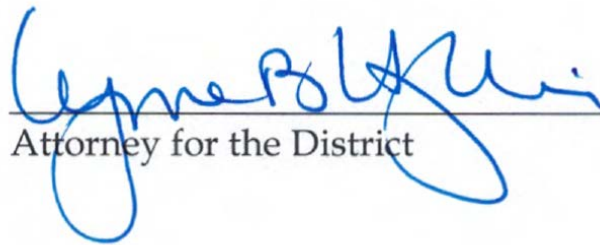
1. Approve minutes.
2. Public comments.\*
3. Update on website and approve postings.
4. Phase II MS4 Stormwater Plan implementation and stormwater permitting matters, including receive public comments.
5. Lake maintenance by Lake Management.
6. Maintenance of the wetland shelves and mowing of District facilities and tree maintenance by Yellowstone Landscape.
7. Engineering matters, including approval of any pay estimates, change orders, design authorizations, advertisement of bids, award of contracts and letter financing agreements:
  - a. deeds, easements and plats, consent to encroachments;
  - b. matters related to City of Sugar Land, Fort Bend County or TxDOT;
  - c. approve work to be done by Ridgewood;
  - d. Brazos River erosion;
  - e. erosion in Ditch H;
  - f. wetlands bed plantings;
  - g. maintenance and capital improvement plan;
  - h. two dimensional drainage analysis and existing conditions survey;
  - i. weir wall diversion;
  - j. Section 28 control gate;
  - k. development in the District; and
  - l. other engineering matters.
8. Park development and maintenance, including:
  - a. adopt Resolution Authorizing Application to the TCEQ for Approval of Project and Series 2020 Park Bonds;
  - b. approve maintenance and repair memorandum from Telfair Community Association, Inc.; and
  - c. ownership of the concrete and brick fences located within the District's owned and common areas.

\*An opportunity for the public to address the Board for items on or not on the agenda. All public must observe a three-minute time limit.

  - b. adopt Resolution Voting for Director for Board of Director Election for Fort Bend Central Appraisal District.

  - a. Restated and Amended Cost Sharing Agreement with University of Houston to finance improvements to drainage system;
  - b. review insurance proposals and approve if appropriate; and
  - c. adopt Resolution Changing and Establishing Additional Out of District Meeting Places.
